### Biography

Tetsugo Hyakutake was born in Japan. After working for Fujifilm Imaging in Tokyo, Hyakutake moved to Philadelphia and graduated from the University of the Arts with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography, receiving the Promising Artist Award and Society for Photographic Education Mid-Atlantic Region Scholarship Award. In 2009, Hyakutake obtained a Master's Degree of Fine Arts from the University of Pennsylvania where he was awarded a Toby Devan Lewis Fellowship. His work has been exhibited in Tokyo, Philadelphia, New York, Madrid, and he is currently represented by Gallery339 in Philadelphia and Alan Klotz Gallery in New York. Hyakutake's work has been acquired for a number of notable corporate and public collections, including those of BlackRock, Fidelity Investments, the West Collection, and the Library of Congress.
